

2014: YEAR OF CHANGES IN THE DORSET BREED

Many new things happened in the Dorset breed for 2014 and it was an exciting year. The introduction of the CDC's own registry program has been met very favorably. The CDC was able to input NSIP performance data on the printed registration certificates, start a new Dorset Advantage registry and produce registration papers that are more legible and actually prints the new transfer information on the papers instead of having to do that outside of the program. A big thank-you goes to Frank Tiffany, a Horned Dorset breeder from New York, for developing the program for the CDC and providing excellent tech support to the

CDC for maintainment of the

program.



The CDC re-structured Dorset show classes for shows and sales. Many national and regional events implemented these classes and it is the hopes for even more expansion in 2015. The All American Junior Show was the first major national event that instituted the new classes. The show had classes for fitted and slick shorn breeding sheep, wether sires & dams, and Dorset Advantage ewes and wethers. It was one of the most successful junior Dorset shows to date. Looking for-


ward to the continual growth in the future.

The Dorset Advantage registry had an excellent first year. The CDC registered 119 head for 46 different breeders, and transferred 65 head. Many of these purchases were for juniors showing Dorset Advantage sheep in their local and state shows. It should be noted that Dorset Advantage sheep are considered their own breed so, when you are showing at an event where there are not separate classes for them, then they should be shown in the AOB division. There was also a new Dorset Advantage division put into the very popular Dorset Ewe Futurity program. No one took advantage of this new division last year so, please remember it this year when you are selling DA ewe lambs online or at the National Sale in Sedalia to nominate ewe lambs for juniors to purchase and be eligible to participate in the program.

Speaking of the futurity ewe program, last year the CDC opened up the nominations to include online sales. It proved

to be very successful for breeders as 29 additional head were nominated for the futurity program and half of them bought by juniors. In fact the national winning horned dorset ewe lamb bred by Sink/Padgett Horned Dorsets, was purchased in their spring online sale. Please continue to nominate your ewe lambs in public sales. whether online or in person, to support the Dorset Futurity program so juniors can earn premiums to offset the cost of their new investments.





Finally, a big shout out to all of the Dorset youth who have worked so hard this year, showing and presenting their favorite breed




of sheep across the country. The Dorset breed was very well represented in Louisville at the National Shows in all events including leadline, market lamb and breeding sheep showmanship. The National Junior Dorset Association had an excellent get together and Annual meeting. It is one of the rewards of working for a breed association, to see its young breeders develop along the way, not only with their sheep skills but into wonderful young adults. Thank-you for allowing the Dorset breed to be part of that ride.



LETTER FROM CDC PRESIDENT JOHNNIE JOHNSON

Hello Everyone,

I hope everyone had a good fall lambing and I hope your spring lambing is going well! Here in California we finally got some very much needed rain and it's nice to see the grass growing again.

The Board had a meeting in early December and I wanted to give everyone an update on some of the issues the board discussed. The first issue is in regards to a partnership with NSA (National Sheep Association). If some of you don't know what NSA is, it is a National association that is designed for junior exhibitors throughout the United States to have regional shows for registered purebred and crossbred wether type breeding stock. Initially the NSA wanted to start their own registry and the funds would then be used to support the shows. With a lot of communication with all the registries and NSA, NSA agreed to not start a new registry and requested that each registry would contribute to NSA. We all agree that this is a great idea for the youth, but the board had some additional questions in regards to and are requesting from NSA for a more clearer detailed proposal/contract to include accountability for the funding the CDC would be ask to provide and to cover in more detail the proposed partnership and both associations' responsibilities to that partnership. The CDC is waiting to hear back from NSA before taking further action but is looking forward to pursuing this new partnership for the purebred sheep industry.

I also, wanted to let everyone know that the board voted to increase transfers under 60 days to \$10.00 per head and transfer over 60 days to \$15.00 effective as of January 1, 2015 with the purpose of generating extra funding for the promotion of junior activities in the Dorset breed.

And lastly, the CDC has developed our own registry with the hard work of Debbie and Frank Tiffany. There have been offers from other registries to purchase our program or have the CDC register other association's sheep for them. These are two avenues the board is seriously looking at because it could possibly lead to generating more revenue for CDC. I also wanted to remind members to get your Hall of Fame nominations in as soon as possible.

I hope everyone has a safe and quick end to their winter!!!!



2014 CDC BOARD FALL TELE-CONFERENCE MEETING MINUTES

The meeting was called to order by President Johnnie Johnson at 7:38 PM EST on December 4, 2014. Directors online were: Casey Sidwell, Mark lunghuhn, Coulter Passwaters, Dick Reece and Mike Wright. CDC Exec/ Sec/Treas. Deb Hopkins was also on-line to take minutes. Stan Poe joined later on the discussion of the NSA proposal and Bret Oelke joined later for discussion on the Midwest Stud Ram

-Secretary's Report: Deb Hopkins presented in writing the meeting minutes from the 2014 Annual Board Meeting held March 20, 2014 in Richmond, IN. Casey Sidwell moved to accept the minutes as printed. Coulter Passwaters seconded. Motion carried.

-Treasurer's Report: Deb Hopkins presented the current fiscal report for the time period from September 1, 2014 to November 25, 2014. It was reported that total income was \$13,061.49; total expenses were \$20,320,59, for a net loss for the period of \$7,259.10. Account balances were: Checking \$11,662.96, Money Market \$10,100.77, CD \$25,837.13, Dexter Savings \$25.00, Junior Association \$32,947.04 for a total of \$80,572.90 on hand. Dick Reece moved to accept the treasurer's report. Casey Sidwell seconded. Motion carried. Deb Hopkins reported that the 2013-2014 fiscal records were going to the accountants for the annual tax from filing and noted that the association's bottom line was \$4,446.57 in the red due primarily to decrease in registrations this year and balance of computer program development payment.

-CDC Stats: Deb Hopkins reported the current 2014-2015 stats and 703 head have been registered to date (up 103 head from last year) and 500 head transferred (down 27 head from last year). There has also been 4 head of Dorset Advantage Ewes registered and transferred in that time period. Deb Hopkins also reported the year-end stats for 2013-2014. There were 5402 head registered (down 863 head from the previous year) and transferred 2,997 head (down 35 head from the previous year. The top fifteen states in registrations were: 1)Indiana 614 head; 2) Iowa 600: 3)Pennsylvania 464; 4)Illinois 443; 5)Ohio 358; 6)Minnesota 305; 7)Virginia 302; 8) California 293; 9) Oklahoma 203; 10) Wisconsin 173; 11) South Dakota 174; 12)Kansas 172; 13)Nebraska 149; 14)New York 127; 15)Oregon 121. The top

-Correspondence: Deb Hopkins reported that she has received many thank-you notes and letters from participants in the Louisville judging contests including the 4-H Skil-athon Contest as the CDC sponsors awards in all of the judging events in Louisville and from the contest organizers themselves. The CDC also received thank-you's from many All American participants and a Midwest Preview Show participant.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

-Dorset Futurity: Deb Hopkins presented the final futurity standings for the 2014 program. A total of \$3,075 was paid out to 20 participants. Average payout was \$153.75. Awards and rosettes were presented to regional and national winners for an additional \$515.15. There were 84 polled ewe lambs nominated for the program taking in \$2,100 in nomination fees. 37 polled ewe lambs were purchased by juniors and eligible for participation. The yearling ewe program had 7 nominations taking in \$175 in nomination fees. The horned ewe lamb futurity had 46 ewe lambs nominated taking in \$1075 in nomination fees. 12 horned ewe lambs were purchased by juniors and eligible for participation. Deb did note that there were no participants in the newly added Dorset Advantage Ewe Lamb division but hopefully this year with Midwest Sale actually having that particular division in the sale and with more information getting out to breeders to nominate lambs that participation will happen. She also noted that 29 ewe lambs were nominated in online sales which helped with the decreasing ewe lamb numbers at the consignment sales.

-Breed Standard Education: Deb Hop-

kins reported that there have never been any additional pictures submitted to complete the Breed Standard Manual so no hard printed copies have been made. It is on the CDC website for reference for breeders and judges. Deb also reported that no breed standard educational activity was done at the NJDA Annual meeting so unless there is a volunteer to organize this effort she suggest that it be discontinued. So noted. Coulter Passwaters moved to add Mike Driscoll and Dustin Cruit to the Dorset Certified Judges list. Dick Reece seconded. Motion carried.

-Production Committee: Nothing to report at this time, except to note that the free service of epd data submitted with registration applications are now being put on the registration papers, thanks to our new registry program.

-Newsletter/Webpage: Deb Hopkins reported that the 2014 Fall Online Edition of the newsletter went very well and there was an increase in advertising support. The online newsletter had 6 ads in it and netted \$436.25 in income. Plans are underway for the 2015 Winter Issue and to date has 8 breeders signed up for ads.
-Dorset Breeder Spotlight: Deb Hopkins asked if there is no one to step up to do the interviews to call this a dead issue. So

noted.

-All-American Junior Show: Casey Sidwell and Dick Reece reported that the 2014 Kansas show went very well and reported that the new Dorset classes and Dorset Advantage show was very well received by not only the exhibitors but by the judge of the event as well. Participation was excellent in all divisions and the first time Dorset showman mementos, a CDC logo etched brush, was very well received by the exhibitors. Deb Hopkins reported that the 2015 All-American will be held in West Springfield, MA at the Eastern States Exposition Fairgrounds from July 3-5, 2015. Polled Breeding Sheep, Dorset Wether Sire & Dams, Dorset Advantage and Horned Dorsets will be included. Paul R. Cassell has donated a horned ewe to be sold at the Ohio Sale. Thank-you! Dick Reece said he will get a polled ewe lamb donated. Deb will once again have the sponsorship list available at the Ohio Sale, publicize it directly to the breeders and send notes to donators last year for the Dorset Wether Sires & Dams and Dorset Advantage classes since we will not be able to catch up with them in person until Sedalia. If slots are still open, the list will also be presented at that time. Deb asked if it was okay to continue to send out the raffle tickets in the mail to CDC breeders when they do their first registration work to

assist the All American with raising general funding. Kyle Thayer will be judging the Dorsets. Locally the New England/New York folks have had one organizational meeting and will be having another as they are planning many additional activities for the shows attendees. 2016 All American will be back in Michigan.

-National Junior Dorset Association: Deb Hopkins reported they had a great meeting and the meeting & pizza party was very well attended in Louisville. The association awarded three \$1000 College Scholarships to Josh Polich, CA, Mitchell Donkers, MN and Britton Francis, MO as they had seven excellent candidates apply this year. The new 2014-2015 Officers are: President & Great Lakes Director: Tyler Mvers, OH: Vice President & New England: Lauren Rizzitano, MA; Sec/Treas. & Western Director: Johanna DeJoria, OR; Eastern Director: Olivia Waggoner, PA; Great Plains: Austin Hicks, OK; North Central Director: Britton Francis, MO and Director At-Large: Sarah Moore, IL. The new CDC first time Dorset showman mementos were also handed out at the meeting to the first time NAILE exhibitors.

-Dorset Youth Ewe Purchase Grant: Deb Hopkins reported 20 applications have been received that will need to be reviewed and two winners selected. Casey Sidwell, Johnnie Johnson and Coulter Passwaters will review the applications once again and winners will be announced early January so winners can make their Dorset ewe purchase plans.

-Dorset Hall of Fame: Deb Hopkins reported that she has some names already submitted. Nominations need to be in by February 1, 2015. This program has been very well received and it is such a great way to recognize the builders of the Dorset breed and to be able to honor them at the annual membership meetings. Johnnie Johnson moved to have a board tele-conference early February to elect the 2015 class and make presentation plans. Casey Sidwell seconded. Motion carried.

-OLD BUSINESS:

-2015 New England & Great Lake Director Elections: Deb Hopkins reported that the committee chairmen were announced in the fall newsletter. The committees have received all of their directions from the CDC office as nominees need to be sent into the office during January for voting in February.

-Mike Squires Proposals: Mike Wright reported for the committee on their review of Mike's proposals. It was enacted on at the last board meeting that First time Dorset showman in the All American And NAILE Junior Shows be presented first time show mementos. This has been accomplished. It was also discussed that the additional

awards to be presented at national junior shows for best headed animals and more divisional champions, that outside sponsors would be more than welcomed but the CDC was not financially stable at this point to take on more new awards as we do spend over \$18,000 annually on junior programming as a whole. On the slick shearing issue of Horned Dorset females in all shows and sales, this would really need to go across whole breed and be a referendum type vote for approval. As far as recommending Horned Dorsets be shown as their own breed at a show and if not enough numbers go into AOB instead of being showed with Polled Dorsets, that

recommendation does already exist but do encourage the local situation be taken into consideration to assure that Dorsets keep their own division. President Johnnie Johnson will comprise a response letter to Mike.

-Trademarking of "Dorsets": Mark lunghuhn reported that he did do some research and it can be done but a lawyer would need to be involved and monetary costs would be required. The board will not take any action at this time.

-Registry Program and/or Registry Service: With the development of the Dorset new registry system Deb reported continued on page 14

that there has been some interest from other breed associations on the possibility or buying or having the CDC register sheep. It was asked to know what the pleasure of the CDC was on this. The board felt that providing direct registry service for smaller breed regsitries was the way to go for the CDC and asked Deb to draw up financial figures to be presented to associations to be brought before the CDC board for approval.

-NSA Partnership Proposal with the CDC: Stan Poe, Chairman of the NSA Steering Committee came online to discuss the partnership proposal and answer any questions the board of directors had about NSA purpose and goals. Thanks was given to Stan for coming into the meeting and discussing the program. After much discussion the board directed Deb Hopkins to contact Stan Poe and NSA, to ask for a more detailed proposal/contract to include accountability for the funding the CDC would be asked to provide and to cover in more detail the proposed partnership and both associations' responsibilities to that partnership. After a revised, more detailed partnership/proposal is received. the board would meet to discuss further action.

Casey Sidwell moved to increase transfers under 60 days to \$10.00 per head and transfers over 60 days to \$15.00 effective as of January 1, 2015, with the purpose of generating extra funding for the promotion of junior activities in the Dorset breed. Coulter Passwaters seconded. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS:

-2015 National Sale & Annual Meeting:

The National Sale for both polled and horned Dorsets, Dorset Advantage will be at the Midwest Stud Ram Sale from June 26-28, 2015. Bret Oelke, from the new sale management group Heartland Livestock Services LLC., called into the meeting to update the board on the new changes coming to the Midwest Sale. Bret reported that they would provide a live feed of the sale show also at no charge if it is a National Sale and at cost if it is not designated a national sale. They are working on condensing sales and providing social activities. They are aiming at a kick off of wether sire/dam sales on Friday night in which Dorset would be included. Dorset Advantage division will be included so the CDC can recognize National Sale Champions for them. Awards for champions would be provided but any additional awards would be up to the CDC and Deb requested the dorm cafeteria for a breakfast annual meeting on Friday. The board of directors meeting will be Thursday. Deb will contact sale management to arrange a meeting room possibility. It was also requested to have a phone set-up available for those directors who might not be able to attend in person. Deb has already been in contact with the Missouri Dorset folks and they are on board for providing a complimentary breakfast to the annual meeting attendees.

-NAILE National Dorset Shows: Attending board members, Dick Reece, Mike Wright and Coulter Passwaters commented on the shows and things went very well for the Dorset breed. There was a great junior Polled Dorset show with 146 entered by 65 different exhibitors, and the horned junior show 38 head but need to make sure we keep that number up as a major exhibitor will age out next year. Entries were down in the Open Polled Dorset Show and the Horned Dorset show held steady. 2015 Judge Nominations were selected for the ballots as follows: Polled Dorsets: Evan Snyder, Matt Scramlin, Steve Reid and Horned Dorsets: Judy Moore, Matt Scramlin, Mike Wright. These names will be put on the ballots send out to NAILE exhibitors for preference ranking submitted to NAILE.

Deb Hopkins also reported on her meeting with NAILE Sheep Committee Chairman Mike Hancock in the pursuit of getting the updated CDC classes in our National Shows as voted in last year. Deb presented a written proposal as well as discussing where the Dorset breed is at and the need for these class offerings in our national events. No decision will be made until next spring as the CDC will officially present this proposal to the NAILE Executive Committee once again. Mark lunghuhn volunteered to go to the NAILE Sheep Committee meeting along with Deb in March.


AS OF JANUARY 1st: TRANSFER FEE INCREASE VOTED

The CDC Board of Directors voted to increase transfer fees to \$10.00 per head under 60 days and \$15.00 per head over 60 days starting January 1st 2015. The primary reason for this increase is to generate revenue for Dorset junior activities. The cost of doing business for the CDC continues to increase. The CDC Board felt this fee increase was needed to generate revenue to maintain quality member services and to promote the Dorset breed in all areas of the purebred sheep industry, including more junior programming.

The CDC operates on one general budget and all income generated is budgeted towards cost of doing business, promoting the Dorset breed in the entire purebred sheep industry, providing services to the membership to assist them in marketing and raising their Dorset sheep, and providing for junior programs to get youth involved in the Dorset breed, as they are the future adult breeders of Dorset sheep.

The CDC has not asked for a fee increase in over 7 years and felt an increase to a transfer of a sold, value added animal would be easier for breeders to adsorb than raising registration fees. The CDC is also investigating other sources of revenue resourcing to maintain its quality services for members besides just increasing member

Thank-you for your understanding and helping your national Dorset breed association to remain financially strong so they can continue to serve the Dorset breed at the highest level.

Feeding and Managing Your Bred Ewe Lambs

Lifetime performance is an often overlooked measurement in sheep operations. Ewes that produce a lamb at a year of age should have a higher lifetime production than a ewe that lambs for the first time at two years of age. However, these young ewes are not only producing a lamb, they are also still growing. So, producers should manage these ewe lambs differently than mature ewes.

When selecting ewe lambs to breed, keep in mind that you will have better success if you start by selecting lambs that were born early in the season and from productive ewes. Lambs that were born earlier in the lambing season are more likely to be further along in their maturity and are thus more likely to conceive. As with any selection process, start with looking at performance records and then go to the barn to assess muscling and structural soundness. Ask yourself "Does this ewe lamb meet the criteria that I value in a brood ewe?" If she doesn't, then

send her to the market. Keep only those ewes who meet your benchmark for performance.

A good rule of thumb is that ewe lambs should weigh at least 70% of their mature weight at breeding. Lambs should be managed so that they are not excessively fat because fat will accumulate in the udder and decrease overall milk production. If lambs are thin, flush them with either high quality pasture or feed a grain supplement. Corn is probably the most widely used supplemental feed and can be fed at a rate of 3/4 to 1 1/4 lb. per head per day. Research has shown that this increased energy will improve body condition and can lead to increased

ovulation rates and result in increased lambing percentages. Flushing should start approximately two weeks prior to the breeding season and continue for four weeks after the ram is turned out with the ewe lambs.

Feeding ewe lambs during the early part of gestation is relatively the same as feeding them before breeding season. The most important time for feeding ewe lambs will occur during the last third of gestation. At this

time the lamb or lambs gain most of their weight prior to birth. So, ewe lambs require nutrition to support this growth as well as their own continued growth. Bred ewe lambs should be gradually switched over to higher quality forage at this time. Ewe lambs may also require a grain supplement, depending on their body condition and the nutritional value of the forage. Nutrient dense feeds are very important at this point because the lambs will take up a large amount of space inside the ewe, which will limit how much she can eat. Poor nutrition can lead to problems such as pregnancy disease, weak or lighter birth weight lambs, and decreased milk production.

Ideally, ewe lambs should be separated from the mature ewes during the last part of gestation. Some producers breed ewe lambs later than the mature ewes. This can allow producers to manage the ewes as one large group for a short period of time. Ewe lambs receive higher nutrition throughout the pregnancy to support their growth while the mature ewes receive higher nutrition only during the last part of gestation. Once all the mature ewes have lambed, the ewe lambs continue to receive higher levels of nutrition throughout the last part of their gestation and then throughout the period of time they nurse their lamb or lambs. Bear in mind that adequate feeder space must be provided so that ewe lambs are not pushed away from

> feed by the larger mature ewes. If adequate feeder space is not available, then manage the ewe lambs as a group separate from the mature ewes to insure they receive adequate nutrition.

When ewe lambs are bred to lamb later than mature ewes, this also gives producers an opportunity to spend more time with ewes lambing for the first time. In some cases, they may not the most aggravating tasks for me at lambing time is to have an older ewe that has not lambed yet, try to take a lamb away from a young ewe. So, if all the mature ewes have already lambed,

be as aggressive at mothering as an older ewe. One of These ewe lambs are grouped separately from mature ewes to insure that they receive additional nutrition to support their growth as well as that of their lambs. this pretty well eliminates this problem. Young ewes have

a better opportunity to mother their lamb without getting bullied!


Not all producers breed their ewe lambs. But, if you do breed ewe lambs be mindful that they are still growing themselves and require a higher plane of nutrition to support their growth and that of the lambs. Best of luck with your lambing in 2015!

2015 DORSET YOUTH GRANT PROGRAM WINNERS ANNOUNCED


