NSIP : DORSET BREEDERS UTILIZING THE PROGRAM EXTENDING

Dorset breeders enrolled in the NSIP program is expanding and creating more accurate data performance numbers for the breed. This data is provided in EBV's and they can actually be supplied to the CDC when registering your animals and put on your registration papers at no additional cost.

NSIP has added a new Eastern Sale this year that was held in Wooster, OH to their already existing one in Iowa. Purebred registered Dorsets were sold in both sales and actually had more participation in the new sale. The demand for "Dorsets with numbers" is increasing in the commercial world as producers are operating on small profit margins so obtaining breeding stock that can assist in increasing lambing percentages and increase pounds of lamb weaned per ewe, becomes ever so important.

Estimated Breeding Values or EBVs are science-based, industrytested measurements of heritable traits that can be tracked and measured. EBVs are proven to improve on-farm productivity and enhance breeding decisions.

Many economically important traits cannot be determined by visual appraisal alone. Using EBVs is the proven method of accurately predicting if an animal will pass on important traits such as growth rate, reproduc proficiency, carcass quality, wool

quality, and parasite resistance.

EBVs begin with on-farm production data but then convert it to actionable genetic information. Performance data is adjusted for variables that are not related to genetics, such as flock management techniques. And, EBVs are calculated on the performance of the individual animal, related animals in the same flock, and related animals in other flocks.

DORSET COMMERCIAL CONNECTION

Do Your Sheep Consume Enough Calcium?

I think all sheep producers understand the concept that sheep require certain levels of minerals in order to stay healthy. Minerals are essential to support skeletal and nervous system functions. But, have you balanced your current mineral program lately with the forages and other feeds that your sheep are consuming? Mineral programs should start with testing forages and other feeds consumed by the sheep. This is the only way to truly evaluate a mineral program. Assess nutrient levels using wet chemistry analysis rather than near infrared (NIR). Not only do you need to evaluate mineral levels in feed rations, but you should also compare ratios of some nutrients.

Calcium levels become particularly important during late gestation. Lambs begin to grow rapidly during the last third of the pregnancy and the ewe requires more calcium in her diet. Consider a 150 pound ewe's requirements that increase from 2.4 grams per day at maintenance levels to 6.5 grams per day in early gestation and then 8.8 grams per day in late gestation if she is carrying twins.

Many forages will meet nutritional requirements of ewes at maintenance and possibly even through mid-gestation. However, rations may need closer inspection to best balance nutrients for late gestation, lactation (milk production), or for growing lambs. Legumes are much higher in calcium than grasses and could better meet calcium requirements. But, simply changing forages is not the answer to better meet nutritional requirements! Keep in mind that the sheep's ration needs balanced with other nutrients as well as protein and energy.

One other major consideration when looking at calcium is the ratio of calcium to phosphorus in the sheep's ration. The recommended ratio of calcium to phosphorus from the Sheep Production Handbook is 2:1, with higher levels tolerable up to 7:1 if the ration contains adequate amounts of phosphorus. In the instance of a ewe carrying twins in late gestation, calcium levels that are too low can result in hypocalcemia, also called milk fever. Clinical signs include weakness, lack of appetite, muscle tremors and inability to stand. Most shepherds would consider pregnancy toxemia as the issue. However, ewes in good body condition that are consuming adequate levels of energy in their feed should not develop problems with pregnancy toxemia. So, the next consideration should be hypocalcemia. Consult your veterinarian for treatment procedures, which will likely involve administering calcium intravenously to treat the deficiency.

Incorrect calcium to phosphorus ratios can also lead to urinary calculi in rams and wethers. As the calcium to phosphorus ratio approaches 1:1, the incidence of urinary calculi increases greatly. This results when mineral deposits block the urinary tract. Affected sheep have difficulty urinating and often stomp their feet or kick at their belly. This condition is sometimes called waterbelly because the blocked urinary tract can cause the bladder to rupture and result in death. This issue often affects feedlot lambs, but can be prevented by adding ammonium chloride at a rate of 0.5% of the total ration. The ammonium chloride acts by acidifying the urine, which helps to prevent the mineral deposits from developing. A constant supply of clean, fresh water, and access to salt also helps to prevent urinary calculi. In young and rapidly growing animals, calcium works along with phosphorus and vitamin D to produce strong bones. A lamb can develop rickets from deficiencies or imbalances of any of these nutrients, although it is most often caused by phosphorus or vitamin D deficiencies. Rickets appears as swollen ends of the leg bones and lameness. Fractures often occur when lambs suffer from rickets.

Calcium and the calcium to phosphorus ratio is critical to sheep nutritional, but calcium is just one of many minerals important to the overall health of the flock. Always consult with your local veterinarian or a nutritionist to balance rations. Properly balanced rations can result in improved growth as well as reproductive performance within the flock and lead to higher profitability.



Most forages and a good quality mineral mix meet nutritional requirements of mature ewes. But, ewes will need additional mineral supplements, particularly during the last month of gestation.

Please note that junior show sheep do not have to send in matching funds unless they are staying on to be shown in the open shows.

Since we now have three types of Dorsets being shown, there will be three Premier Exhibitor banners presented: Fitted, Slick Shorn and Wether Type. Group classes are still shown together, and the groups must be of the similar division to participate in the classes, this is primarily because the flock class placing breaks ties in premier exhibitor calculations.

For those of you unable to attend the shows in person, all shows can be viewed live streamed by going to the North American International Livestock Show website.

Looking forward to seeing everyone in Louisville this year and to another great set of National Dorset Shows!

2017 DORSET EWE FUTURITY UPDATE

The Dorset Ewe Futurity Program has once again been active this year with point records forms coming into the CDC office. A total of \$3,550 has been raised to pay out to the participants of the Dorset futurity divisions.

We had two group nominators this year, Cassell Horned Dorsets, Wytheville, VA and Casey Sidwell, Gill, CO. Thank-you to the 49 nominators for supporting this program once again! A complete list of all the breeder nominators are listed on the back cover of this newsletter. 141 ewe lambs have been nominated this year, 103 polled ewe lambs, 3 Dorset Advantage and 36 horned dorsets. Of those, 63 have been designated by their new junior owners for participation in the futurity program. To date the CDC office has received point record forms from 20 of these junior owners.

Online Sales are also eligible to sell futurity nominated ewe lambs. Breeders need to identify the ewe lambs as being futurity nominated in their sale information, and then notify the CDC and pay your nomination fees. Dorset Wether type sheep and Dorset Advantage ewe lambs are also eligible. In fact the Dorset Advantage already has its own division but unfortunately this year only 3 lambs were nominated for the program limiting the possibility of junior buyers to purchase a DA lamb so, that division will not be awarding any premiums this year.

Point record forms need to be received in the CDC office within 21 days of the date of the show or they will not count. They also need to be signed by show management. Deadline to send in Regional Point Record forms into the CDC Office is November 6, 2017. This allows the office enough time to tabulate final regional placing before Louisville. Those regional points will carry over to your Louisville junior show placing if you are attending that show to compete for the separate Louisville premiums.

The yearling ewe division had 10 yearlings nominated. Keep sending those point record forms in on the yearling ewes. The yearling ewe futurity will also end at the National Junior Dorset Show in Louisville like the ewe lamb program.

Since the Annual NJDA Meeting is now post junior show, the regional polled ewe lamb winners and all the final placings for the Polled Ewe Lamb, Horned Ewe Lamb, Dorset Advantage Ewe Lamb and Yearling Ewe divisions will be announced and awards presented at the meeting. The meeting is scheduled for 7:00 PM Saturday November 11, 2017 in meeting room C105. The awards will be given out along with the breeder recognition. Please make plans to be on hand to receive your awards.

The futurity points are updated on a regular basis on the CDC website to keep everyone appraised of point totals. If you have any questions please feel free to contact the CDC Office. The final update will be posted the week before Louisville.

DORSETS REIGN SUPREME

The Dorset breed in the show ring has excelled once again this year! The quality of Dorsets being shown is exceptional and all Dorset breeders should be very proud of their animals. There wasn't a major show around the country, open or youth, where during Supreme Champion drives there wasn't a Dorset pulled out vying for the honor. The numerous actual named Supreme are a true assessment to the quality of the Dorsets being presented in the showring! Congratulations to all of the breeders and exhibitors!

CDC & NDJA YOUTH DORSET EWE PURCHASE GRANT PROGRAM

The National Junior Dorset Association and the CDC introduced a grant program for youth to use towards the purchase of a Dorset ewe and it has been very successful for the past four years. The associations awards three \$500 grants annually to be used towards the purchase of a registered Dorset female.

The purchase does not need to be done through a public consignment sale as on farm purchases are also eligible. The program is open to youth in three age divisions: Junior 8-10 years; Intermediate 11-14 years and Senior 15-18 years. An individual may win each division only one time. The applications are due December 1st of the current year. The winning applicants will receive their grant money upon the completed transfer of the ewe purchased into their names.
