ENTRY FEE: \$15.00 per entry, per class. **No limit to total number of head entered** & Entries Closes on **June 12, 2019.** The Junior Breeding Sheep Show will be held **July 11-15.** American System of Judging. Ribbons through 5th Place. Entries may be limited after June 13 based on space available.

Special Breeding Sheep Rules

- 1. All exhibitors must read, understand and adhere to the residue avoidance program.
- 2. The California State Fair is continuing its residue avoidance testing program and reserves the right to test any animal officially entered in any division at any time without notice, for any foreign substance including but not limited to drugs, chemicals or feed additives.
- 3. See Livestock Rule concerning Sheep Blocking Tables.
- 4. This is an Open Junior Show. All Junior exhibitors (4-H, FFA, Grange, and Independents) shall compete together in the same classes.
- 5. All Junior exhibitors must wear whites during competition. Official 4-H and FFA uniform is acceptable but not required.
- 6. Management reserves the right to split any classes and will determine implementation of such a process.
- 7. All lambs must have lambs teeth.
- 8. No Hot Shots or Sheep Lamb Racks will be allowed on the Fairgrounds. This does not include blocking tables.
- 9. The Fair reserves the right to collect tissue samples from champions and/or reserves to test for DNA matches and/or sire/dam verification.
- 10. Exhibitors that qualify to compete for California State Fair Junior Supreme

or Reserve Supreme Ram or Ewe must participate in the Supreme/ Reserve Supreme Competition. Exhibitors that choose not to participate in Supreme/Reserve Supreme Champion drive will forfeit all premiums and awards.

- 11. Junior Breeding Sheep that are entered and shown in the Junior Show may also enter and show in the Open Sheep Show provided they 1.) show in the junior show first, and 2.) the exhibitor enters by the open show entry deadline under the open division rules.
- 12. Please be advised; if you remove or rearrange a panel in your assigned pens, you will be required to return the panels to their original location before a release slip is issued. Failure to do so will result in a \$50.00 back charge for each panel our staff has to re-install to its original configuration. Barn assignments will be used to back the bill, so make sure if you change locations in the barns that your show superintendent knows your final location.
- 13. Animals housed in L3 during Junior Livestock Week, July 11-15 may use shavings instead of wheat straw. Exhibitors must clean their pens before obtaining a release.
